



# FELT FLOWER TUTORIAL

Supplies you should gather before starting:

1. Scraps of felt in two different colours (3x3 inches is plenty)
2. Cool button, about 1/2 inch diameter
3. Glue Gun
4. Scissors
5. Object to glue flower onto (bobby pin, hair clip, etc.)

## INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut 5 petal shapes on the small side of 1 inch long out of each colour of felt. You should have 10 total.
2. Cut three circles slightly smaller than your button out of the felt. There should be 1 of one colour and two of the other, it doesn't matter which though. [SEE PIC 1]
3. Decide which colour you want on the top of your flower. I usually pick the lighter of the two.
4. Take one circle and put hot glue on it. Arrange 5 of the same colour petals on it and let the glue set. [SEE PIC 2]
5. Take a second circle and glue it onto the top of the petals.
6. Take your second colour of petals and glue them onto the circle so that they fall between the first set of petals. [SEE PIC 3]
7. Flip the flower over. Take a second to admire it then glue your button onto the middle. [SEE PIC 4]
8. Glue your flower on to item you have chosen.
9. Take the last circle of felt and place it on the other side of them item you glued your flower to. This just makes it more secure and finished-looking. [SEE PIC 5]
10. Admire again and prepare to make more. Sizes can be adjusted as much as you'd like.

Suggestions for uses:

1. headbands, alone or clustered
2. large bobby pins
3. alligator hair clips
4. pins/brooches
5. magnets
6. Anywhere else you see fit!
